

Referral Information

Referrals into the service can be made by health care professionals or by self referral for anyone aged 5 years or over.

All referrals are triaged by a podiatrist against our referral criteria. An assessment appointment is offered if our medical risk and/or foot health criteria are met.

Our service is provided across 5 different locations:

- Farnham Hospital
- Frimley Green Community Clinic
- Aldershot Centre for Health
- Fleet Hospital
- Yateley Medical Centre.

Domiciliary (home) visits are only available to service users who are bed bound, require hoisting or are completely housebound. Service users who leave their home for any medical or social reasons are not eligible.

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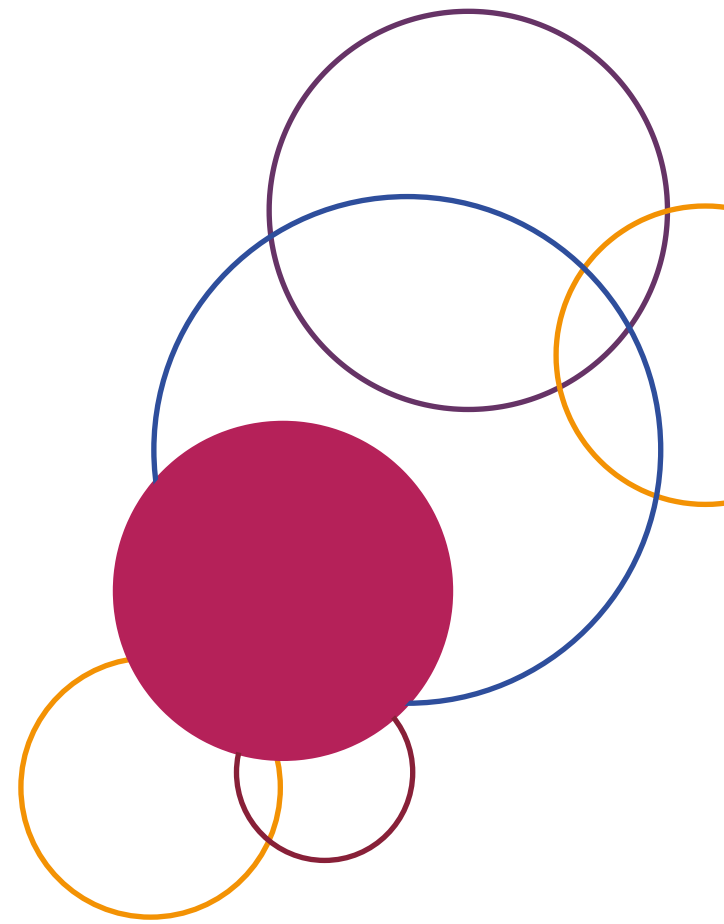

Welcome to the Podiatry Service

We offer assessment, diagnosis and treatment of problems relating to your feet and lower limb.

Our Podiatrists are all registered with the Health and Care Professions Council (HCPC) and are supported by trained assistants.

What treatments do we offer?

- **Ulcer/Woundcare Mangement**

Treatment of new and chronic wounds through dressings, assessment, infection control, offloading and treatment such as debridement, if necessary.



- **High Risk Podiatry**

The podiatry service prioritises treatment for service users with the most high-risk feet that are considered at risk of developing complications including infections, ulceration and amputation. This helps to prevent life and limb threatening complications.

- **Foot Health Education**

We provide simple practical advice about nail and footcare to help you manage your own feet.

- **Nail Surgery**

Treatment of painful ingrowing or pathological nails to provide a long term solution involving partial or total removal of the nail under local anaesthetic.



- **Biomechanics/MSK**

The assessment and diagnosis of acute or chronic musculoskeletal conditions. Treatment aims to reduce pain and other symptoms and can include exercises, footwear advice or prescription of orthoses (insoles).
